Subject: Arctic Master / Talon Vortex Device

Dear Mr. Sheehy;

Trane has reviewed this device and has determined that it should not have any negative effects on the product or system, per se. We cannot test or approve specific devices but recommend that such testing be conducted, preferably in a private testing laboratory by trained third-party technicians and evaluation engineers, under controlled conditions.

Trane warrants its products to be free from defects. If a Trane product is altered or misapplied, or if a device or product is applied to a Trane unit that causes its failure, the Trane warranty would be voided. We understand that these devices have previously been installed on a number of Trane chillers. Trane's only caution in this regard is that anytime a factory sealed and charged system is opened, there is of course a risk of contamination. But, assuming that proper installation practices are followed to prevent refrigeration system contamination, these devices should not impact the factory warranty for the product.
